VIOLENT CRIME

Violent Crime consists of Murder and Nonnegligent Manslaughter, Rape, Robbery and Aggravated Assault. One crime is counted for each victim of Murder, Rape and Aggravated Assault. For Robbery, the number of crimes equals the number of incidents.

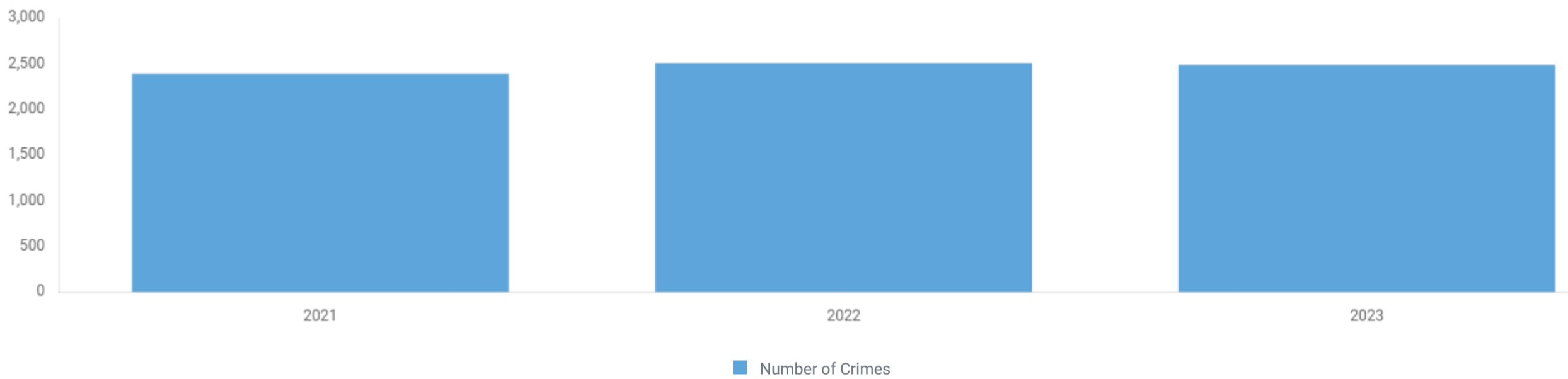

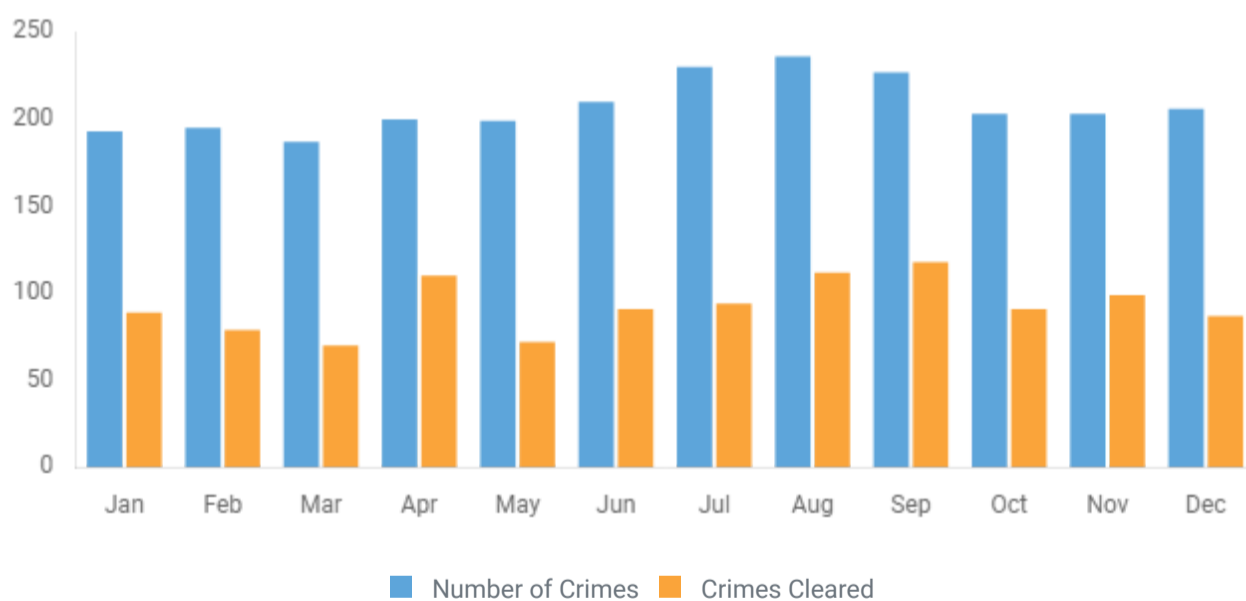

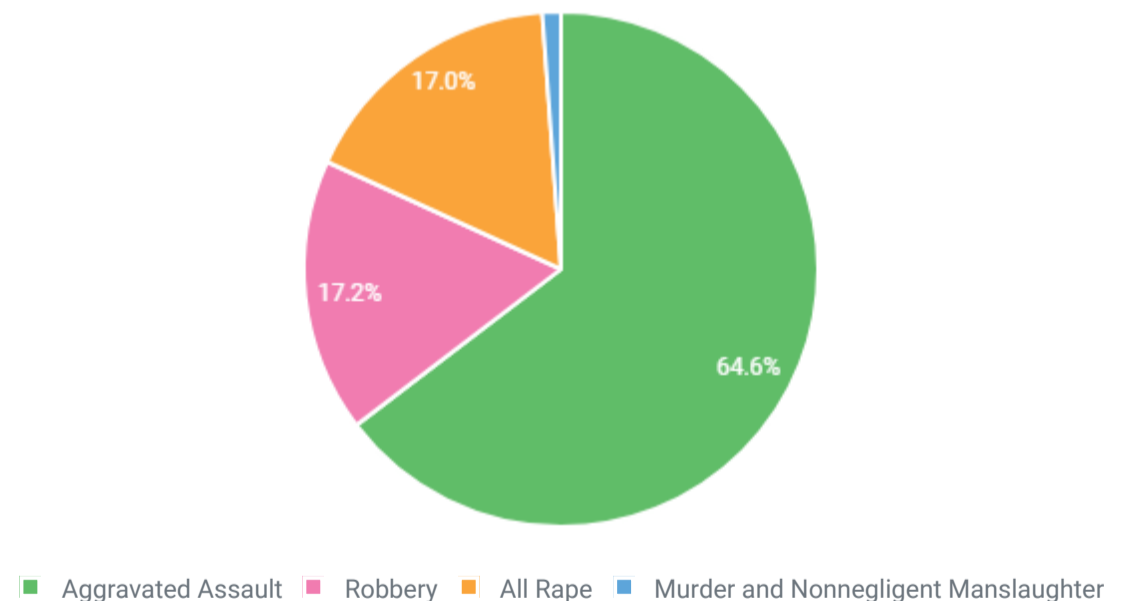

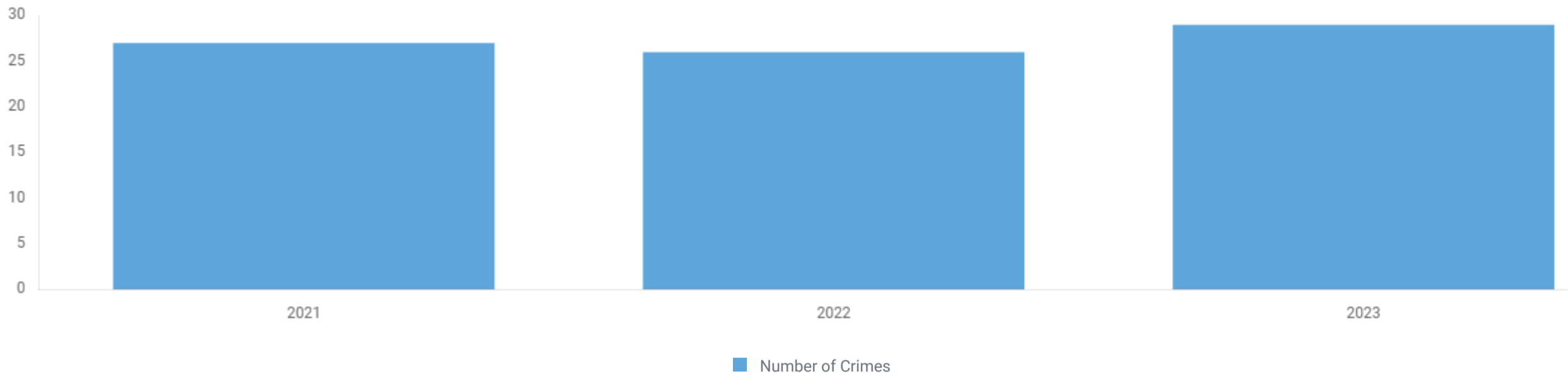

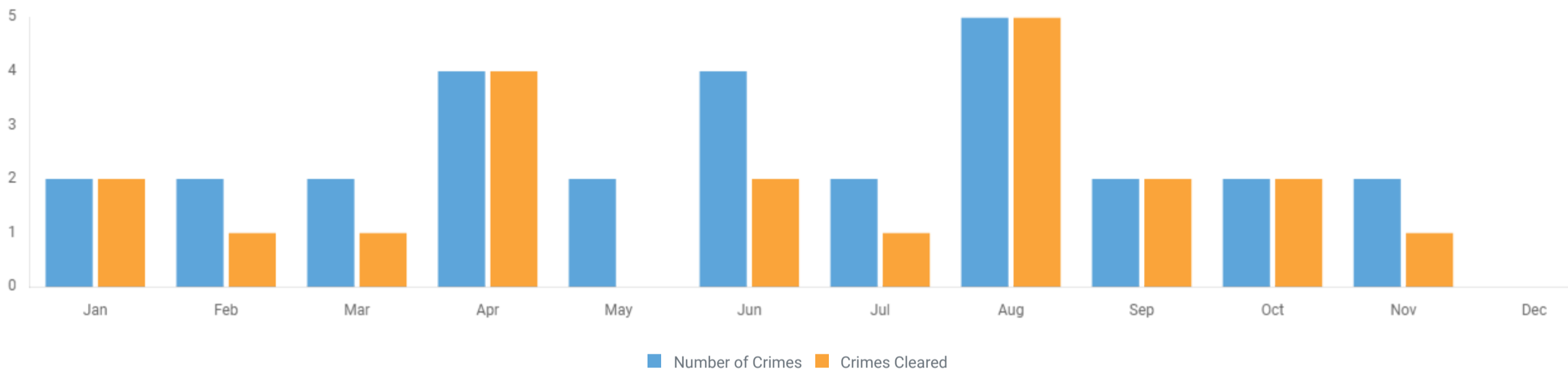

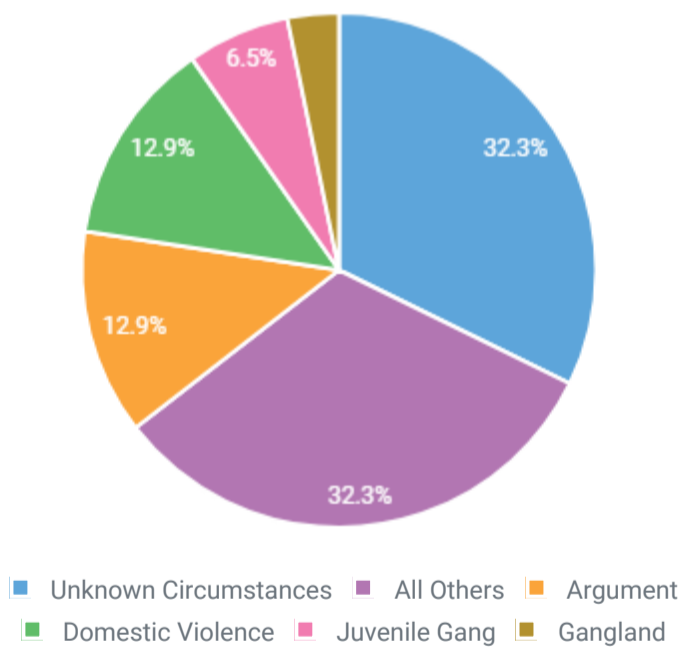

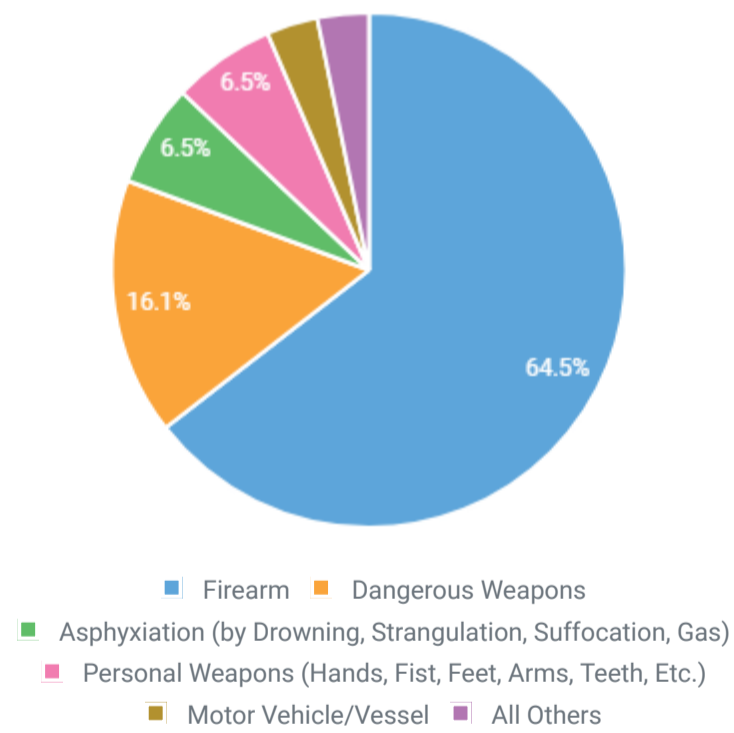
CRIME CIRCUMSTANCE

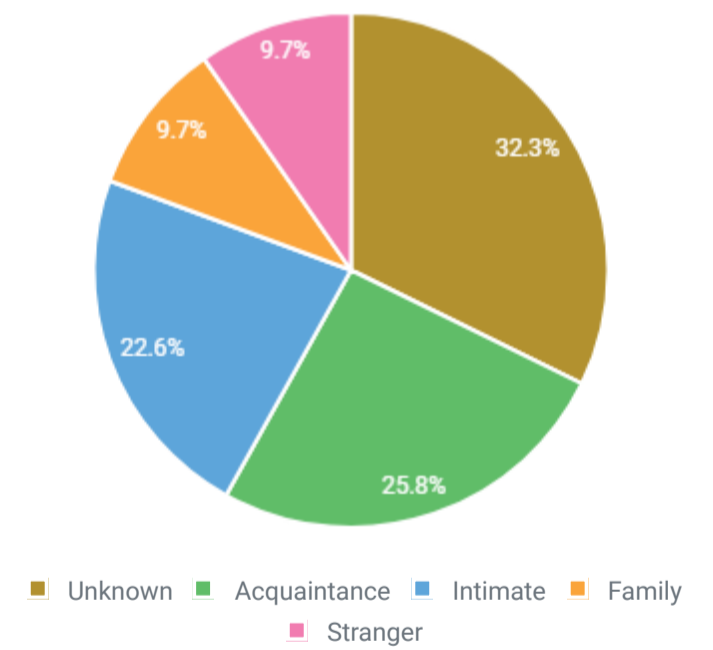

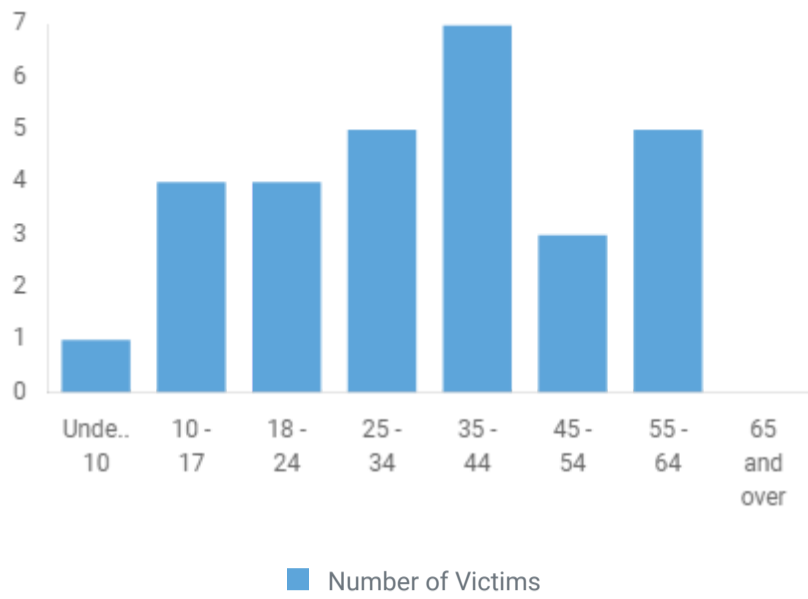
VICTIM TO OFFENDER RELATIONSHIP

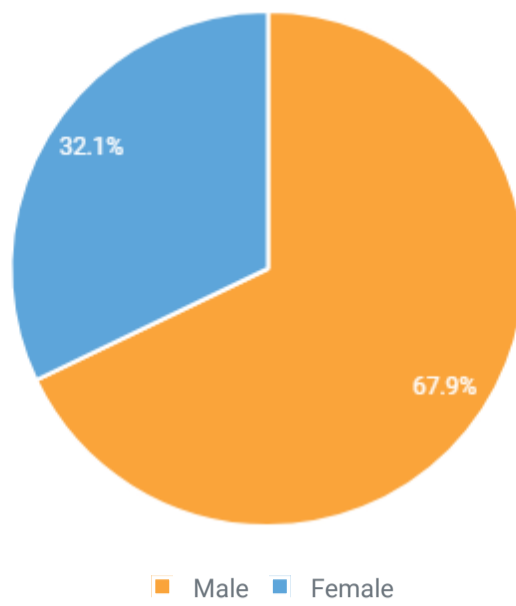
VICTIM AGE

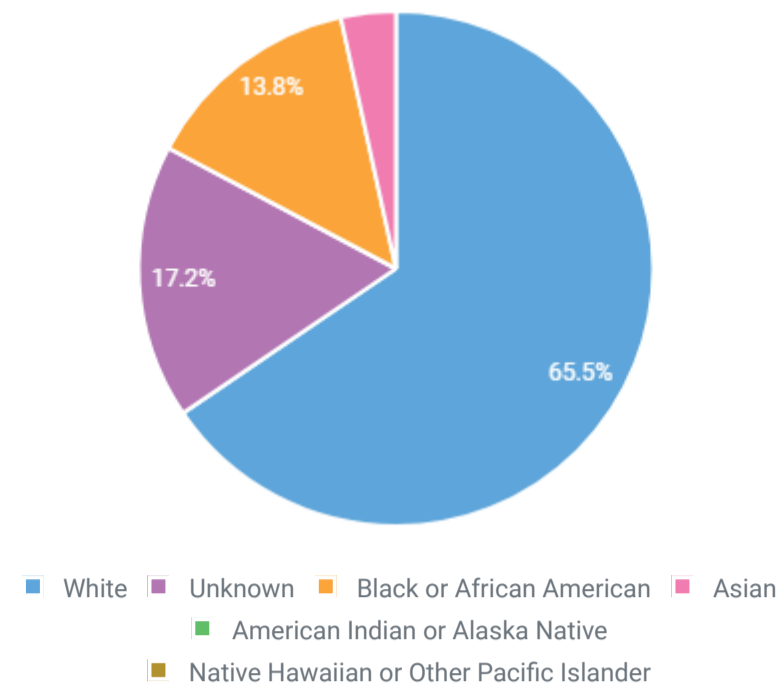
VICTIM GENDER

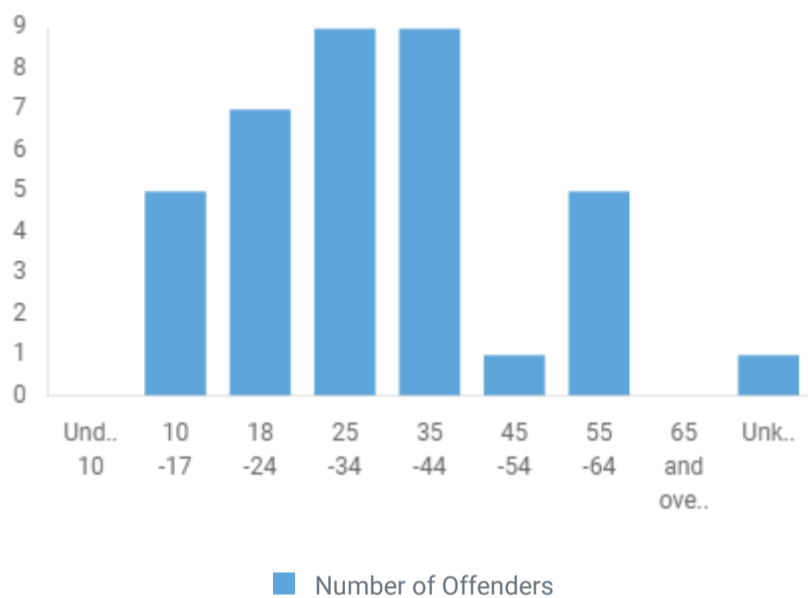

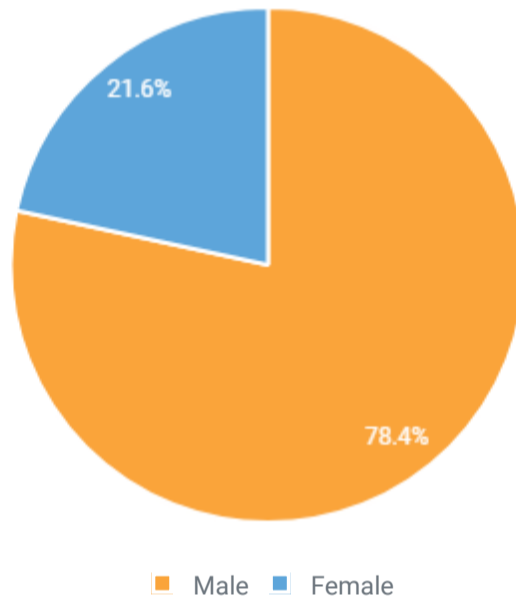

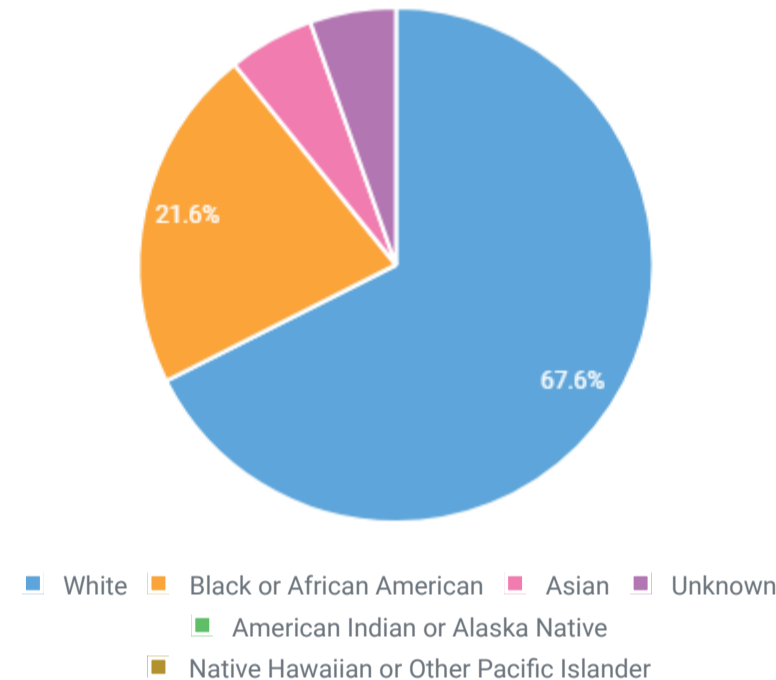
OFFENDER GENDER

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

An unlawful attack by one person upon another wherein the offender uses a weapon or displays it in the threatening manner, or the victim suffers obvious severe or aggravated bodily injury involving apparent broken bones, loss of teeth, possible internal injury, severe laceration, or loss of consciousness. This also includes assault with disease (as in cases where the offender is aware that he/she is infected with a deadly disease and deliberately attempts to inflict the disease by biting, spiting, etc.).

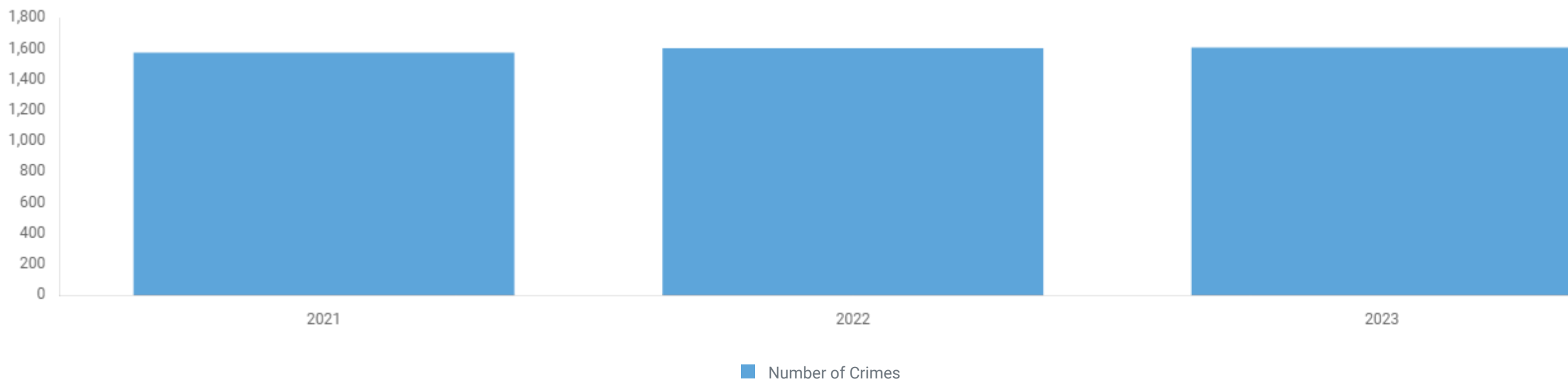

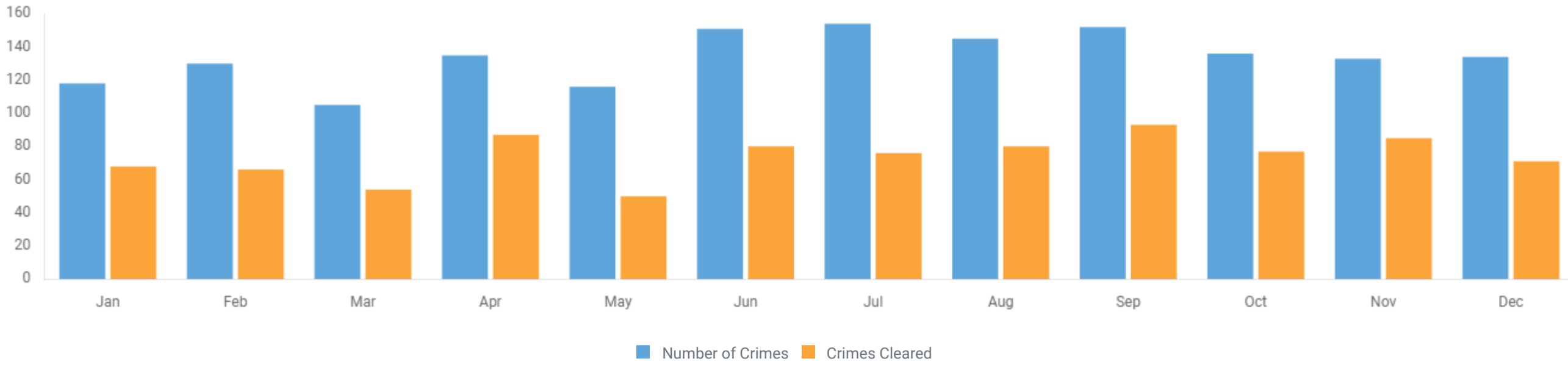

Aggravated Assault



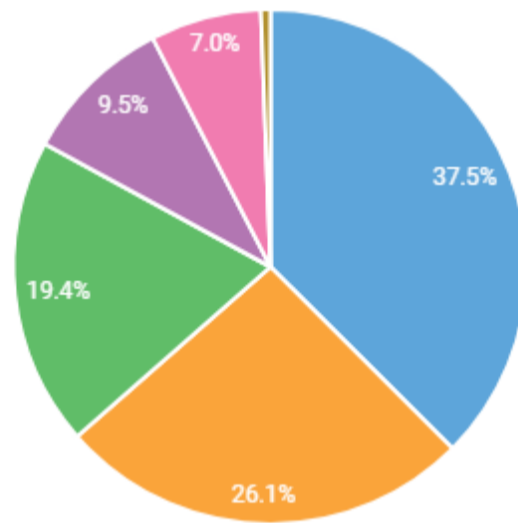

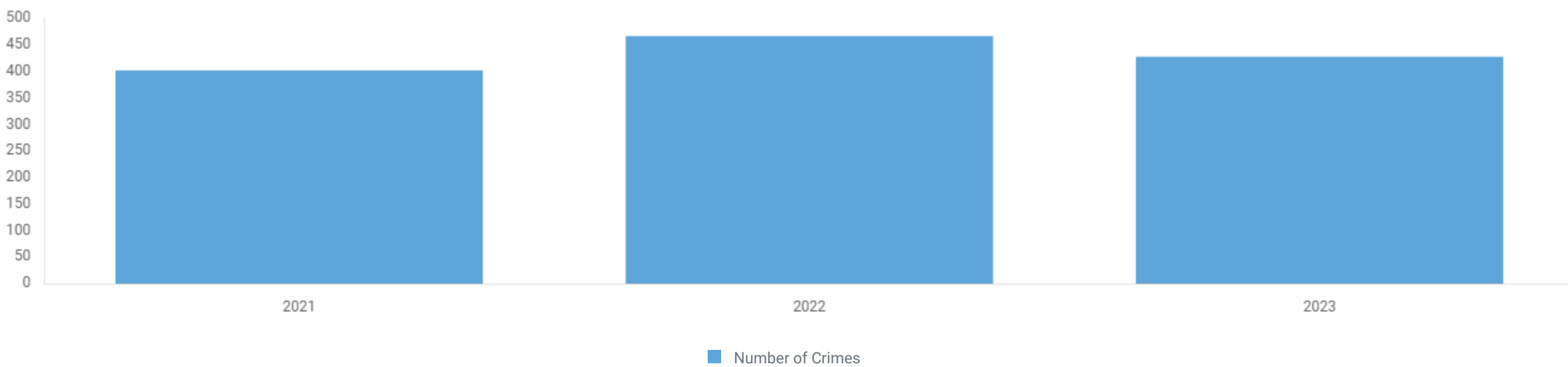

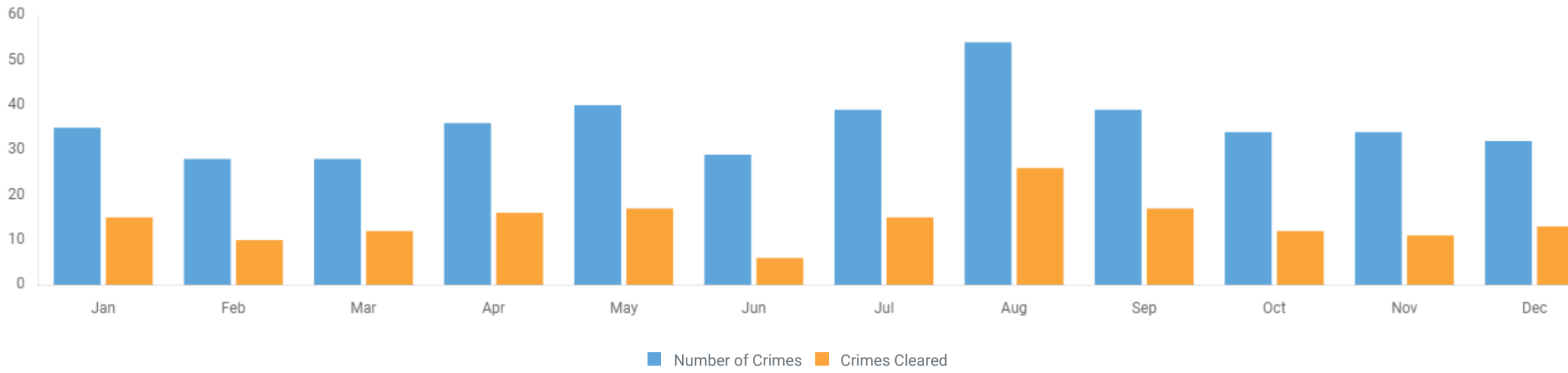

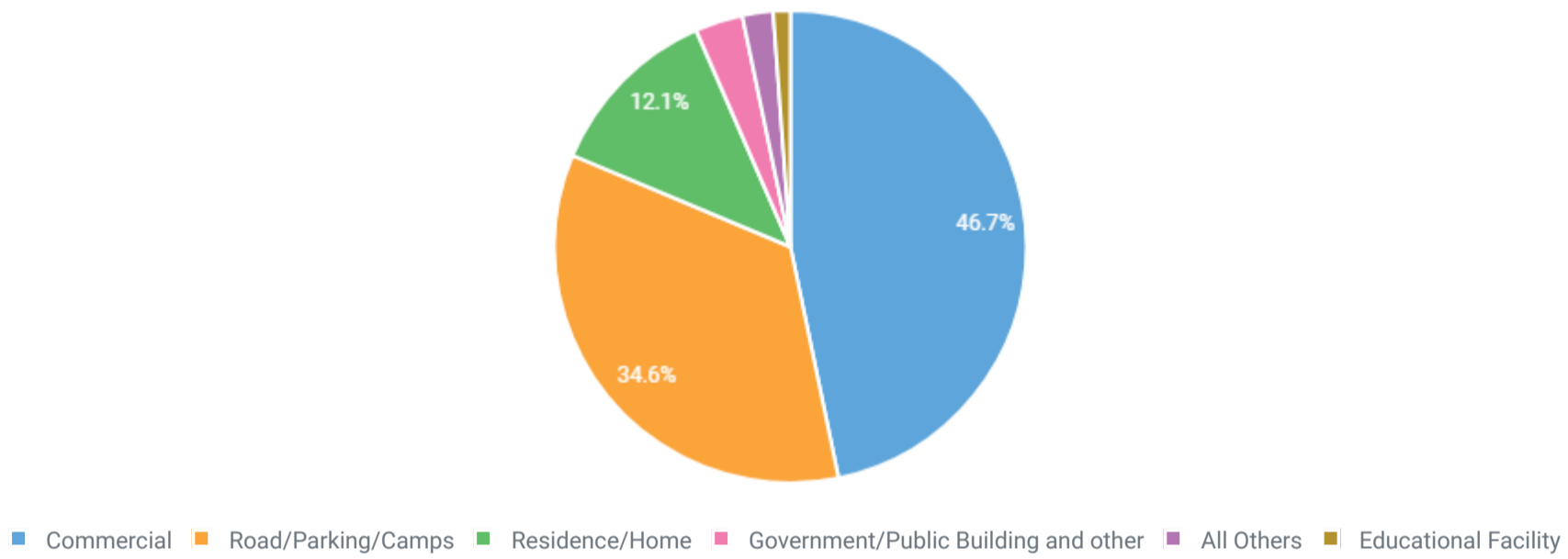

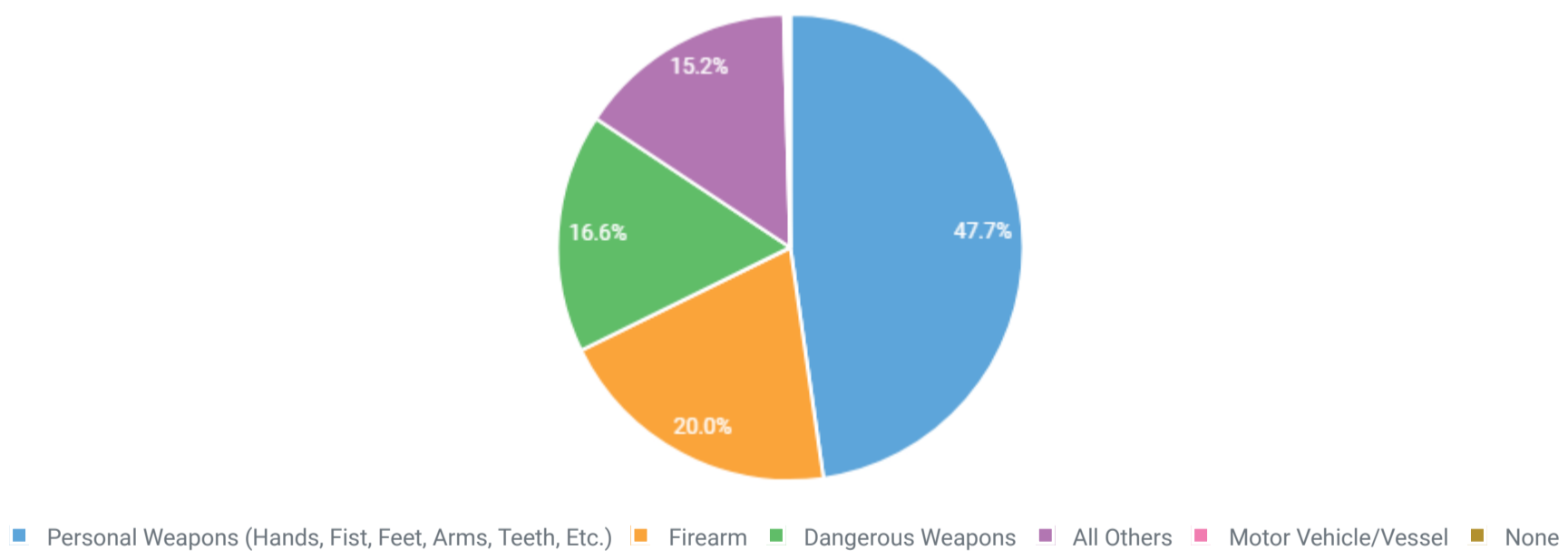
LOCATION TYPE

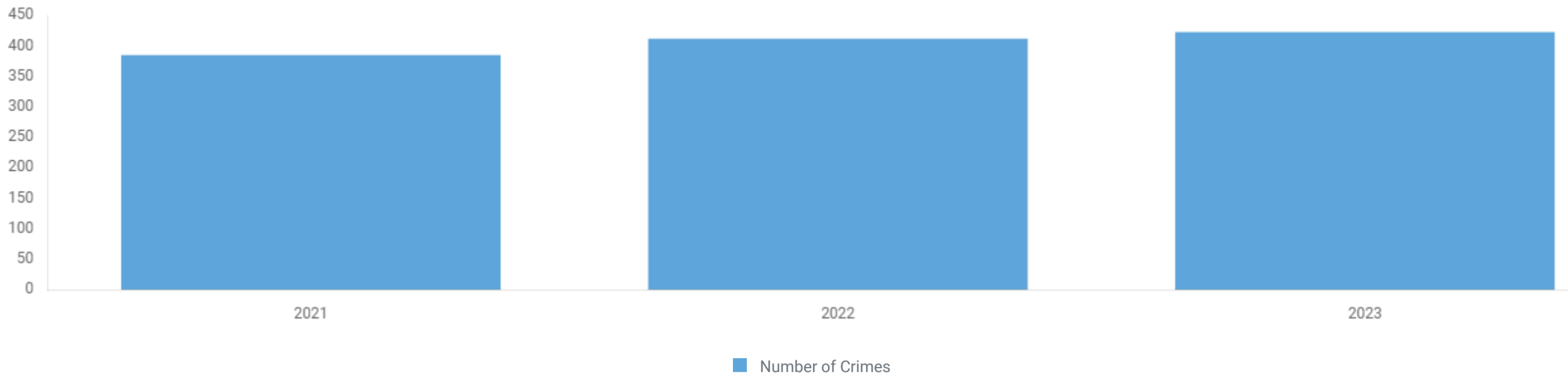

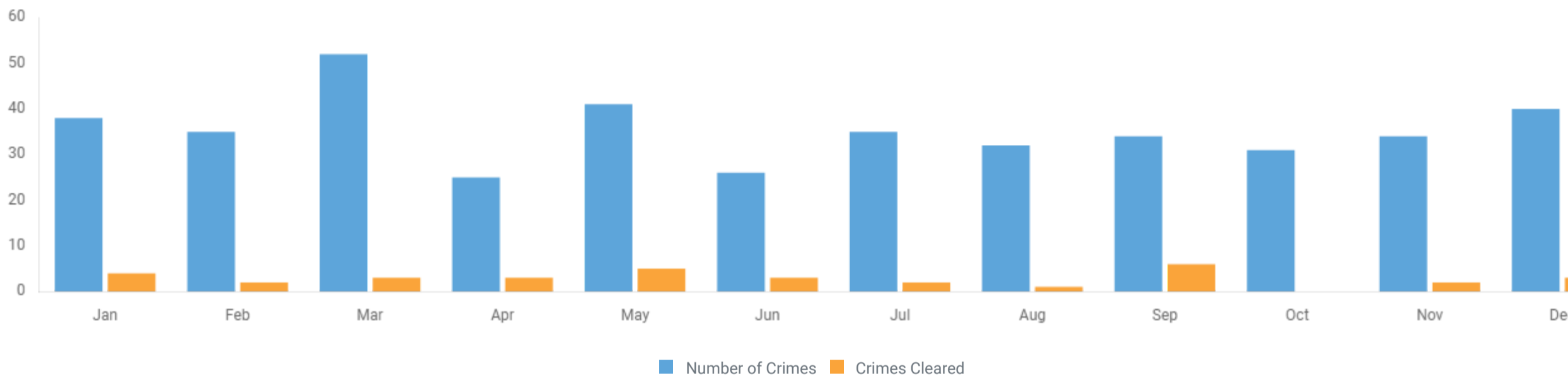

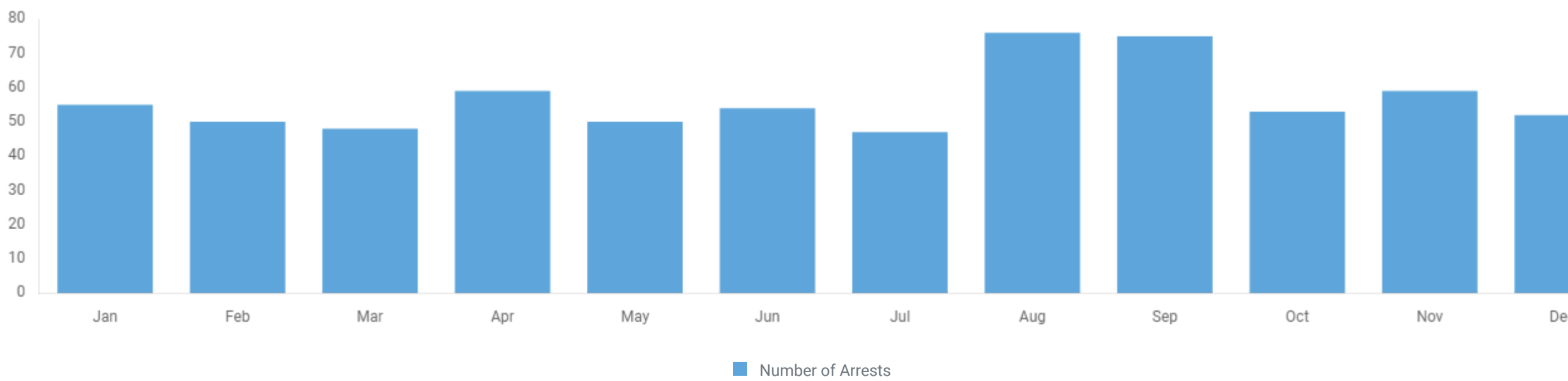

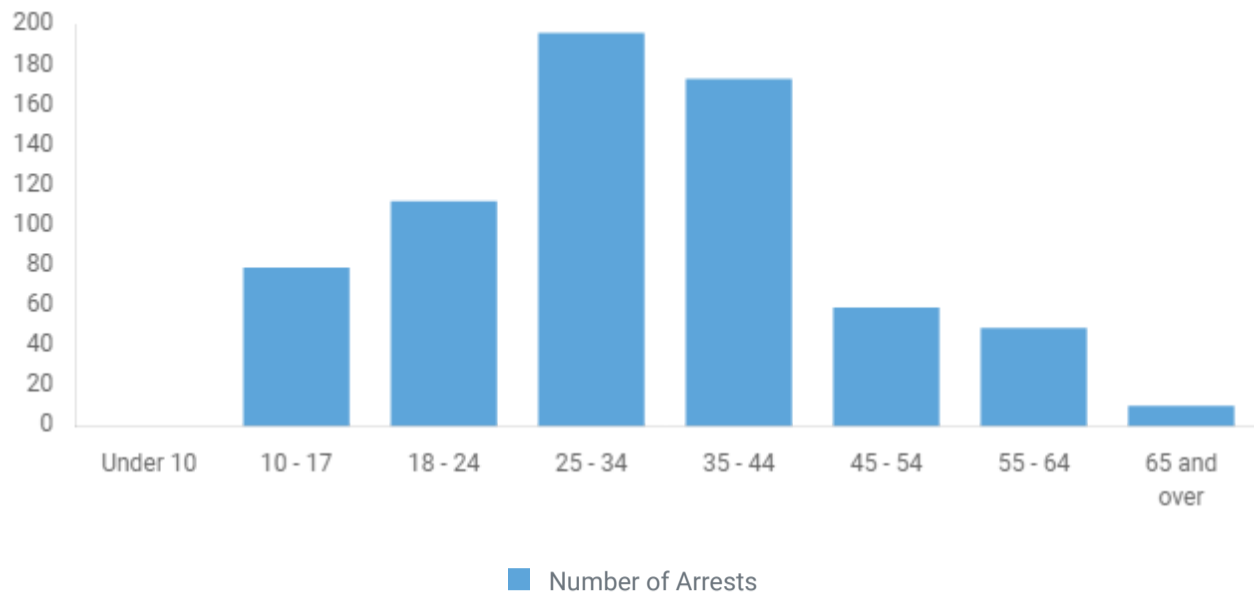

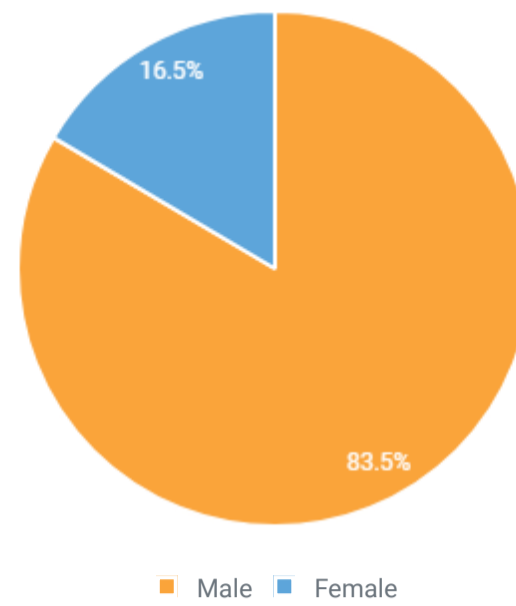
ARRESTEE AGE

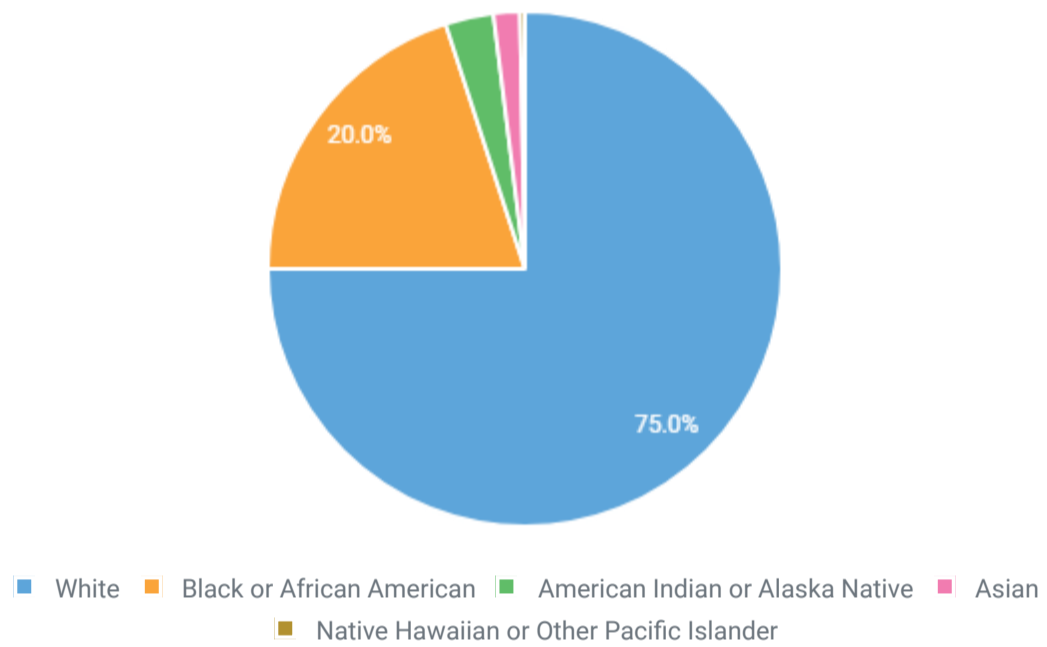
ARRESTEE GENDER
